



All of them great stories about how Jesus saved 3 young men and we welcomed them in our church family. Beginning of the school year is a great time to remind ourselves of why we are here and what is our mission. Seeing new people being baptised is a great reminder of that. We are here to share Jesus with people who don't know him yet. And everything we do is helping us in this purpose. Why we train leaders? Why we disciple people? Why we preach? Why we help those in need? So that people can hear and see Jesus. That is our ultimate goal. It is also great opportunity to hear about what God is doing at different churches in the network. There were many great stories of what God has done during the summer at different camps and retreats.

New season begins The kick off started a new season of our ministries and it has been really amazing. We started our youth ministries, college ministry in Olomouc. We also started a new college group in Brno with about 20 students. English classes started in Vsetin and children's clubs at Velka Lhota.





Leadership training continues New season is also the beginning of our leadership training. We are in the middle of our Pastor Institute. Two classes with 25 students have successfully finished first year of program. This year we have added another program for developing youth leaders. We have about 15 young people who are helping lead different youth programs that are meeting once a month for training and learning.

Is your "vision distorted" as you "look" into your future? Have you "lost sight" of what's truly important? Do you fail to "see" a way to serve our Lord by serving others? Have you been thinking lately how you might get out of your comfort zone and impact the lives of others in a big way?

TEAM Believe In UGanda 2019 has recently returned from our mission trip to the rural villages of Uganda where we served the poorest families in the communities. We are already gearing up for 2020! In fact, we have a lofty goal of taking two teams throughout that summer and you could be part of the team!

As you contemplate this, "look" into your future and what do you "see"? Do you yearn for something more? Going to UGanda in 2008 really helped me "see clearly" that much of my prior life was devoted to me and what I could do for me! God's "vision" for my life had become "fuzzy and out of focus" and left me feeling somewhat empty and restless! I felt there was too much me (self serving) and not enough Him! (God serving) But the "focus" of my life changed dramatically when I put God in charge of where I should be serving to bring HOPE to the HOPELESS! And 11 years later, my heart still breaks for the injustices that I witnessed while serving in the most remote villages of Uganda—but I witnessed JOY in the people that can only be explained by their love and dependence on God for all their basic needs; the same God we serve that blesses our daily lives so abundantly!!! 20-20 Vision cont. from pg. 5

A friend approached me not long ago inquiring about Believe In UGanda mission trips but she wondered whether or not she might have anything to offer the people! Here's my response: If your heart breaks over the plight and condition of the poorest of the poor in our world—this mission trip is for you!! If your heart breaks knowing that children in Uganda often only eat one meal a day— this mission trip is for you!! If your heart breaks knowing that mothers typically deliver their babies on a dirt floor and that children often die because of lack of medical attention—this mission trip is for you!! If your heart breaks knowing that water used daily is infested by microscopic parasites—this mission trip is for you!! If you want to be the hands and feet of Jesus in a very concrete, personal way— this mission trip is for you!! The list goes on and on but because you can help change all the above, you can be part of the solution!! Going, Giving, Praying!!!
