#### From the Pastor's Desk During COVID-19

My dear church family,

We have been under our governor's shelter-in-place order for 11 days, an order which has now been set through the end of April. These days have certainly brought many different experiences to life and faith for us as a church family. I pray that each one of you are doing all you can to keep yourself and others healthy as we move through this time. I pray that your faith is strengthened and that your minds are at peace, because we know that Christ is our Peace. Let me also say and acknowledge that anxiousness can creep in, especially as we are aware of the reports and updates given with each passing day. The unknown can be worrisome, and fear can be a part of the human experience in this life. But God, in his delight over us as his children and his desire for our well-being, does not want us to be afraid. He says to each of us when we become anxious, "*Child, I'm here!*" Remember the straightforward words from our worship experience on Sunday, March 29 – the words of the prophet in Isaiah 41:10.

#### "Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my victorious right hand."

I encourage all of us in these days to wrap our hands around these words – literally, to carry them with you! Let us fill our minds with their power to remind and reassure us that nothing has really changed in this world. It is true, someone has said, that this world is always filled with sorrow. But God is always faithful, never surprised by what happens in any given day or time. He is faithful, and he will deliver us through this and every hardship. Even death has been overcome by Christ's resurrection.
