The FOOTSTEPS of JESUS EXPERIENCE

Join *Pastor John Walker* this May 20-June 3 for a Spiritual Adventure in the Holy Land

The Footsteps of Jesus Experience is a unique two-week journey to the places where Jesus lived, made disciples, built a spiritual family, and fulfilled his mission. We focus on the historically verifiable sites from Jesus' life and the spiritual impact these can have on us personally. The trip begins by exploring the social setting of the Gospels in and around Jerusalem, Judea, and the Dead Sea. Then we follow the course of Jesus' life from his birth in the city of Bethlehem, to the Sea of Galilee where he called his disciples, to the far north of Israel, and then back to Jerusalem for the climactic conclusion of our journey.

Each day will begin with time for prayer and Scripture-reading based on our itinerary that day. We will visit the sites with the greatest historical significance that illuminate the biblical account of Jesus' life. At each site we will offer an overview of the history and archeology and then conclude with a time of biblical reflection, sharing, and prayer. Each day we will pause at a meaningful place for worship and teaching. The evenings will alternate between opportunities for processing in small groups and free time.

The group will be limited to 22 people so we can get to know each other and facilitate more flexible movement. We will stay in Christian guesthouses within the ancient walled city of Jerusalem, in the Old City of Nazareth, and on the peaceful shores of the Sea of Galilee. We visit many sites by foot so participants need to be physically fit and able to walk 5-6 miles a day in warm weather, including hills and stairs.

Before departure you will have the chance to participate in an eight-session online preparatory course introducing the biblical history and archaeology of the sites we will be visiting using lots of visual images. The course includes an extensive handbook with hundreds of maps, plans, charts, and site reconstructions, which will become your reference guide for the trip. This book also includes reflection questions on key Scriptures related to the sites we will be visiting each day and space to do some journaling.

Our trip leaders are Eric Laverentz and John Walker, experienced pastors and teachers who have been trained to lead this pilgrimage. The cost of the trip is \$3250 per person double or triple occupancy, not including airfare to Tel Aviv. This includes all your meals and expenses during the trip.

This is not a tour, it is a spiritual pilgrimage. Many people who have taken this journey with us over the last 25 years have called it the trip of a lifetime. It is certainly an unforgettable experience that will profoundly shape your reading of the Gospels and your walk with Jesus. Go to www.footsteps-experience.com for more information and testimonials. - Friday, May 18/19:** Depart for Tel Aviv, arrive to start by 11:00 AM on Saturday, stay in Old City
- Saturday, May 20:** Jesus' World, Herodians, Sadducees, and Pharisees: introduction to Jerusalem, Temple Mount, Western Wall, Church of the Holy Sepulcher
- Sunday, May 21:** Jesus' World, Romans, Essenes, and Zealots: Qumran, Scroll Caves, Masada, Dead Sea
- Monday, May 22:** Jesus' Birth: Bethlehem, Church of the Nativity, Shepherds' Fields, and Herodium Fortress
- Tuesday, May 23:** Jesus' Baptism and Temptation: River Jordan, Jesus' Baptism site, Wadi Kelt, St. George's Monastery, Wilderness of Judea
- Wednesday, May 24:** Jesus' Home: Jordan Valley, Nazareth Village, House of Mary, Church of the Annunciation, House of Joseph
- Thursday, May 25:** Jesus' Family: Mount Precipice, Sepphoris, Cana of Galilee, Cliffs of Arbel, stay at Sea of Galilee
- Friday, May 26:** Jesus' Family: Capernaum, ancient Galilee Boat, boat trip on the Sea of Galilee, swimming in the lake
- Saturday, May 27:** Jesus' Mission Field: Mount of Beatitudes, Tabgha, Church of the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes, Magdala, First-Century Synagogue, swimming in the lake
- Sunday, May 28:** Jesus' Mission Field: Bethsaida, Hippos, Chorazin, swimming in the lake
- Monday, May 29:** Jesus' Retreats: Gamla, Caesarea Philippi, Banias Waterfalls, return to Jerusalem

Sunday School Classes for All!

GROW all followers to deeper faith - Sunday School classes for all ages at FPC

The Bible ZONE is FPC's Sunday School ministry for kids Pre-K to eighth grade. The word ZONE stands for “**Z**eal for God, **O**neeness in Relationships, **N**urture in God's Word, and **E**xercising our Faith, all of which are our goals. We have two groups, the younger ages (Pre-K to fifth grade), and sixth to eighth grade.

The younger group meets Sunday mornings from 8:15 – 9 am in the East Room (big playroom downstairs). We will be going through the New Testament using a giant felt board with very elaborate and colorful felt pieces to build each Bible lesson. We also spend some time memorizing scripture and catechism. There's usually time for a snack, plenty of paper and crayons/colored pencils for those who love to draw, and time to play. The curriculum is published by Veritas Press and “Through the Bible in Felt” by Betty Lukens.

The older kids up through 8th grade meet after church, from 10:45 – 11:30 am in an upstairs Sunday School room. We will continue to go through scripture in chronologic order. Our conversations are insightful, and it's such a joy to watch our young people grow up and learn about God's Word. The curriculum is by Veritas Press and includes reading scripture and talking about the concepts/events that took place. Can we know what Jesus was truly like during His time on Earth? A first century physician set out to gather eyewitness testimony on the life, teaching, and ministry of Jesus Christ. The result is a close-up account of a compassionate Savior on His journey to redeem His people. The gospel is for believers and skeptics alike, written so “that you may have certainty” (Luke 1:4) about the Son of Man who came to seek and save the lost.

Luke, the beloved physician, saw so clearly the humanness of Jesus that it is no wonder his gospel presents the Lord as Son of Man. With sensitivity he details the birth of the Savior and the relationship of Christ to the people He ministered to.

I hope that you can join us for this exciting study about the life, death and resurrection of Jesus and how our lives are forever changed.

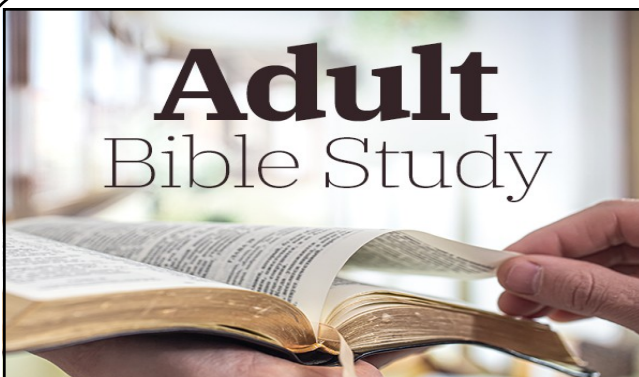
Youth Christian Education
