From the Pastor's Desk: Update on our Building

Dear church family,

You may know FPC's building was closed for entry as of Tuesday night, September 26, 2023 – just over one week ago from the writing of this letter. Here's a brief update on that event and reasons for the actions of both FPC's elders and the Opportunity School Board.

The last step in the wonderful Scott Hall remodeling project was to remove all floor tiling in Scott Hall, along with the kitchen and hallway. On 9/26/23 we discerned there were possible asbestos issues that we previously thought we had properly accounted for and addressed. With additional information related to State asbestos regulations, the Opportunity School administrators and governing board along with FPC's trustees and elders, determined that the best and prudent action to take would be to close the building out of an abundance of caution for all the preschool children and families, along with all FPC church-family members. FPC trustees immediately contacted the certified environmental consulting firm, Midwest Environmental Consulting Services (MECS), to guide us properly through all necessary State regulatory steps to ensure the health of FPC's building environment. On Monday, October 2, MECS conducted tests throughout the entire building and presented the results of those tests on Wednesday, October 4. The test results were the best we all were hoping and praying for. At the writing of this letter, MECS assures us that when these test results are reported to the *Illinois* Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA), that agency's requirements of a complete bill of health for FPC's building will have been met, something the IEPA is expected to confirm in coming days.

Even though test results indicate that our building is clean and safe for reentry, FPC's elders are choosing to go the extra mile. Out of an abundance of caution and a desire to go above and beyond regulatory requirements for the peace of all Opportunity School children and families, *and for our own church family*, FPC's session voted on October 4, with continued assistance from MECS, to pursue bids from cleaning contractors specifically certified to clean and abate any possible residual asbestos from the basement level of our building. It is hoped this will fully assure everyone that they are safe when they enter the building at its reopening.

So, when will the building reopen? Our trustees are working diligently to expedite all the necessary steps to that end, and thus far, both MECS and IEPA have been very helpful in understanding Opportunity School's and FPC's needs. At this writing, I ask everyone to please be patient and continue to pray over all these matters. Pray for the wise and patient leadership of your elders as they work to lead us through this little speedbump. Please pray for the Opportunity School community in the disruption this has been for the children, their families, the teachers, administrators, and board members. As the session receives word of when it looks like we can reopen, we will share it. We hope this can come soon. Please pray.

For now, let's join together in the ADVENTURE! It was hard not to be together in worship last Sunday, but we've got a great alternative for this Sunday, October 8: We will meet just across the parking lot behind FPC in the YMCA in their small gym. The YMCA has graciously opened this space to us for this Sunday, and any succeeding Sundays, should those be needed – I hope that's not the case, but we will have to wait and see. In the meantime, let's not miss out on this rich opportunity we have in our Loving Community of Jesus Christ to trust him in new ways. I think this will actually be a lot of FUN! – a change of environment and routine will draw us nearer to Jesus and to one another. Please don't miss out! Make sure you get in on the adventure and don't miss a moment of what this will be as we choose to trust God and worship him when things are just a bit different.

Come to worship this Sunday at 9:30 AM at the YMCA: Park in the lower parking lot, just behind FPC's building and down the slope to the YMCA. Enter the door into the Y just off the parking lot. Proceed upstairs past the reception desk to the small gym across the hallway. Everything will be clear as you arrive and we will have people to guide you. If you struggle with stairs, we will have doors open for you at the upper entrance to the Y building where Jackson Street turns left past the Y and the east entrance to the Y parking lot. There is also an elevator for use. Sunday school classes will meet after worship in spaces provided at the YMCA.




